A typical tax bill:

The following example depicts no change in taxes from FY26 to FY27 for a constant assessed value of \$575,000 (Martin County's median residential market value as of July 1, 2025), when the tentative combined millage rate is applied. Based on the FY27 tentative millage of 9.9185, a typical County portion of a tax bill would be \$5,703.20 as shown on the example below. This amount includes only County's government millage. Each individual tax bill would be broken down by various rates that apply to the specific area where the home is located.

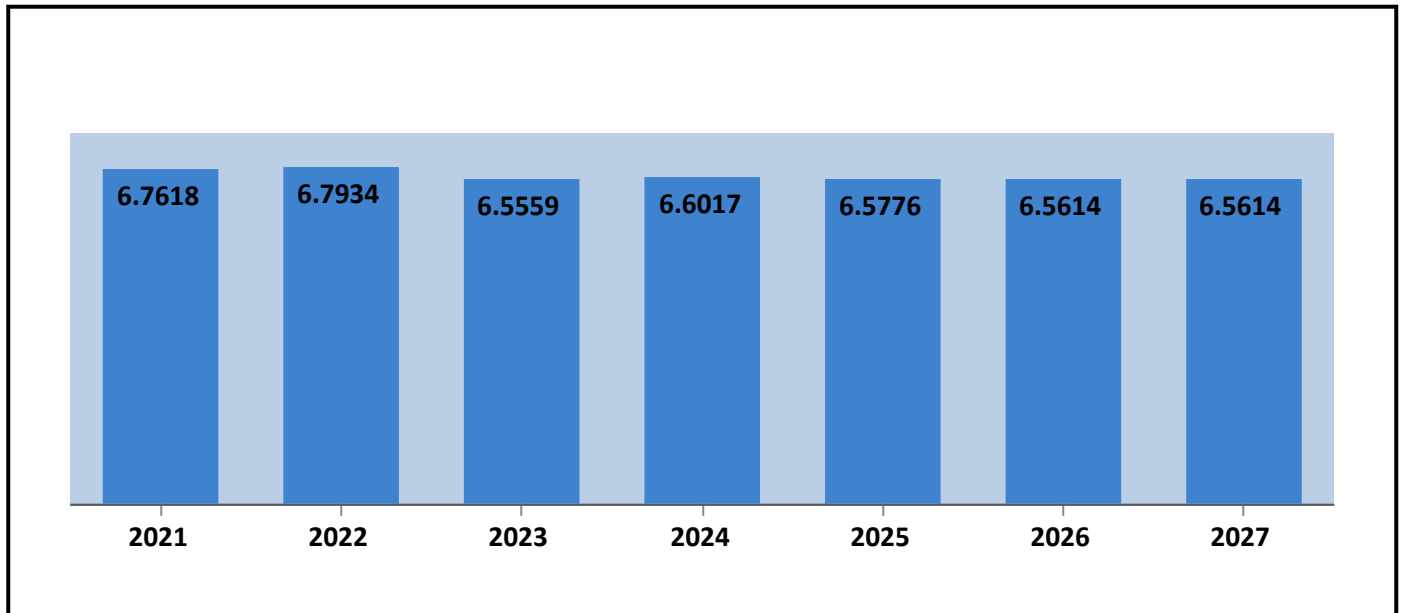

Each of these authorities assesses their own millage and adopts their own annual budgets. The County does not exercise control over the budgets and millage rates of other taxing districts; therefore, their budgets and millage rates are not reflected in the County's budget document.
