

PEDDLER INFORMATION

Licenses and Permits

INTRODUCTION:

A *Peddler* is defined in Sec. 3.209.2 of the Martin County Land Development Regulations as “any person traveling by foot or vehicle, from place to place, offering goods for sale.” (E.g. Person selling flowers from door to door and having no fixed sales location.)

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

As of November 30, 2011, Peddlers in Martin County are no longer required to obtain a Peddler Identification Card from the Growth Management Department. The identification card requirement was dropped pursuant to adoption of Ordinance #901. There is no application to fill out from the Growth Management Department.

The Tax Collector’s Office defines a *Peddler* as operating a home-based business. Any person wishing to operate as a Peddler within Martin County must register with and obtain a “business tax receipt” from the Martin County Tax Collector.

TAX COLLECTOR’S OFFICE:

A Home-Based Business Tax Receipt affidavit is obtained and processed at the Martin County Tax Collector. Please contact the Martin County Tax Collector to inquire about their fees. The primary branch of the Tax Collector’s office is located at 3485 S.E. Willoughby Blvd, Stuart, FL 34994. The Tax Collector can be contacted by phone at (772) 288-5600.

FOR FURTHER INFORMATION:

The Growth Management Department office is in the Martin County Administrative Center at 2401 S.E. Monterey Rd, Stuart. No appointment is necessary, and walk-ins are welcome on a first come, first served basis. No walk-ins will be accepted on Thursdays.
