<input type="checkbox"/> Owner/Builder Disclosure Statement	APPLICABLE TO OWNER/BUILDERS ONLY. An Owner/Builder Disclosure Statement is a legally binding oath required by Florida Statute in order to be issued a building permit in your name. The Disclosure Statement affirms your certification of compliance with the limitations imposed upon you by Florida Statute 489.503(6) in order to be exempt from professional licensure requirements as an Owner/Builder. Also provide Product Approval for all roof adhesives.

<input type="checkbox"/> Martin County Re-Roof Certification Form	This form identifies roof symmetry, decking, old roof covering, as well as proposed. 7 th Edition (2020) FBC/Residential/Building 107.2.1.	Martin County Re-Roof Certification Form
<input type="checkbox"/> Reroof Windstorm Loss Certification	This form identifies re-nailing and secondary water barrier requirements. (Does not apply to mobile homes, modular homes.) Need a copy of Martin County's Reroof Windstorm Loss Mitigation Certification Form. 7 th Edition (2020) FBC/Existing Building Code 706.7.2.	Re-roof Windstorm Loss Certification

<input type="checkbox"/> Product Approval	Product approvals/Notices of Acceptance are published, pre-approved construction assemblies associated with specific materials, assemblies and construction methods that have been specifically tested in accordance with Florida requirements and ultimately have received a valid product approval designation that demonstrates compliance with the applicable building code requirements. <input type="checkbox"/> Manufacturers' Specifications	Please provide specifications on the structure: These are printed brochures from the manufacturers explaining limitations and installation of their products inclusive of all details, sizes, lengths, attachments, and details showing the construction of the structure. 7th Edition (2020) FBC/Residential/Building 107.2.1.	
<input type="checkbox"/> Roofing Material List	These are the Florida product approval materials you will be using on the roof. 7th Edition (2020) FBC/Residential 107.2.1.	Roofing Material List
<input type="checkbox"/> Substantial Improvement Determination Checklist Form	Substantial Improvement Determination is required to determine if the cumulative value of improvements equals or exceeds 50% of the value of the structure being improved within a Special Flood Hazard Area that do not comply with current Flood Protection Regulations. This applies to all structures, residential or commercial, that are open and available to the public. DOES NOT APPLY to improvements on an accessory structure such as a shed or storage unit. The property owner must complete and sign the Substantial Improvement Determination Checklist Form, have his or her signature notarized and submit the completed form with the Building Permit Application and other documentation.
