



ENGINEERING DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED PRIOR TO SCHEDULING DEV REV SITE ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION

Effective July 1, 2008, the Site Acceptance Inspection of a project will not be scheduled until the Engineering Department has received and been provided at least five (5) business days to review the following “close out” documentation:

1. A signed and sealed copy of the Engineers Certification of Construction Completion, which also requires:
 - a. a copy of the completed South Florida Water Management District’s construction completion certification form, if applicable;
 - b. original Record Drawings signed and sealed by the professional engineer of record licensed in the state of Florida **or** an original “as-built” survey signed and sealed by a professional surveyor and mapper licensed in the state of Florida;
 - c. an electronic copy of the record drawings and “as-built” survey in **.pdf** format; **and** **CADD**;
 - d. Original density tests signed and sealed by a professional engineer licensed in the state of Florida.
2. A written request for reduction in security from the engineer of record, if applicable.
