Please take a few minutes to check out the new and improved projects portal at www.martin.fl.us/projects, where users can search for both county and private development projects. From this page, users may choose to search for information related to county projects included in the Capital Improvement Program or private, proposed development projects located within Martin County.

Enhancements have been made to the search functionality for proposed development projects, which are private projects including residential, commercial and industrial applications currently approved or under review. Users may simply select the "Proposed Development Projects" option and can then search by project location, keyword, commission district or the file number found on the yellow proposed development sign at each site. The search process is more user friendly and the maps and content have been updated and refined.

To find out more about roads, bridges, wastewater and stormwater systems, parks and other projects being constructed by Martin County, simply select the "County Projects" option. Search by keyword, location, commission district or type of project and find information such as a project description, status, photos, project contact and more.
