

WHILE YOU SLEEP, WE SWEEP

Last year, Martin County Field Operations swept 768 miles of roadways in Martin County. This is the distance you would drive from Stuart all the way to New Orleans, Louisiana! While sweeping, we removed 278,000 lbs. (139 tons) of debris from the roadways.

If you were to put our street sweeping debris from 1 year into 1 cubic foot sized cubes, you would have enough to fill 6,908 cubes. If stacked, these cubes would be 5.5 times higher than the Empire State Building.
