APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants seeking eligibility must provide a valid Government issued Veteran's Photo ID, proof of Martin County residency, a telephone number, and emergency contact information.

ELIGIBLE RIDES

- **Health:** Medical/Dental/Eye appointments, substance use support, mental health support, Medicare/Medicaid services, Pharmacy services, Veterans Affairs Services.
- **Nutrition:** Grocery stores, SNAP/WIC benefits access.
- **Martin County Government Offices:** Administration Building, Courthouse, Libraries, etc.
- **Economic Stability:** Banks, Record Obtainment
- **First mile/Last mile:** Trips to and from any Public Transportation (Marty) bus stop located in Martin County (Includes Route 20X to the VA Medical Center in Palm Beach and Route 1 to Walmart in Port St. Lucie).
