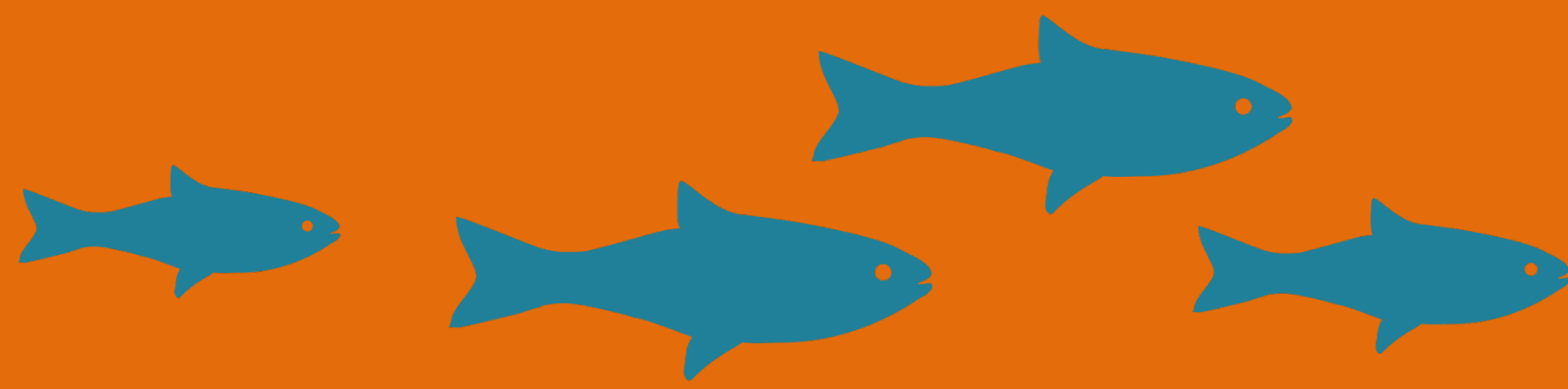


Martin County Integrated Mosquito Control Program

Many residents need effective mosquito control that does not rely upon chemicals. Gambusia fish are natural predators of mosquito larvae and can be used to control mosquitoes.

To meet the needs of our residents, and reduce reliance upon insecticides, Mosquito Control invested in a 1,000 gallon Gambusia rearing tank. We consulted with the Butte County Mosquito and Vector Control District and Fintastic Aquariums to get the tank up and running.
